

# Stony Brook University MBA Fast Track Program: Earn Your Undergraduate Degree and Your MBA in 5 years

The Stony Brook MBA Fast Track Program combines non-business undergraduate studies with a graduate-level business education. This program is designed specifically for high-achieving, motivated students in certain non-business majors. It increases marketability and career possibilities.

### Program Description:

The MBA Fast Track program combines a four year undergraduate degree and a 48 credit MBA into a program that can be completed in about five years. Undergraduate students apply for this program in their sophomore or junior year and begin taking graduate MBA

courses along with their undergraduate course of study in their junior or senior year. Students typically finish their MBA in their fifth year. The MBA degree has become increasingly popular for students considering careers in business, healthcare, law, science, research, and other professions. It is the degree of choice for anyone interested in taking on a leadership role in an organization. Our program provides students with opportunities to gain real-world experience through projects and internships with companies in a variety of industries, including private and public companies, not-for-profit organizations, as well. Its hands-on approach has earned a reputation as one of the great learning experiences at Stony Brook.

### Admission Requirements:

- Must be a current SBU undergraduate from an approved major
- Minimum SBU 3.2 GPA
- 3 credit calculus class—C or better: MAT 122 or 125
- One page application, personal statement & resume
- Transcripts from universities attended other than SBU (can be unofficial)
- 2-3 letters of recommendation
- Interview with admissions committee
